ABOUT EDUCATION, RESEARCH, COMMUNITY SERVICE AND PUBLICATION

Today, Saturday 13, January, Year Two Thousand and Twenty-Four, The undersigned below:

1. **Syaiful Anam, M.Pd:** Chairman STAI Nurul Qadim, Paiton Probolinggo, East Java, In his position he acts for and on behalf of the STAI Nurul Qadim, Paiton Probolinggo which is located on Road Kalikajar Kulon, Paiton Probolinggo, hereinafter referred to as the **FIRST PARTY**
2. **Prof . Faisol Mahmoud Adam Ibrahim :** Responsible for University Of The Holy Qur'an And Islamic Sciences Omdarman, Sudan. hereinafter referred to as the **SECOND PARTY**

THE FIRST PARTY and **THE SECOND PARTY**, then **BOTH PARTIES** agreed and agreed to sign a Memorandum of Understanding and cooperate based on the following terms and conditions:

Article 1

SCOPE OF COOPERATION

Policies regarding forms of cooperation within the scope of this agreement include;

1. **Education and teaching:** both parties agreed to organizing various educational and teaching programs in activity schemes; public lectures, national and international seminars, workshops, *visiting lecturer* for outstanding lecturers, exchange of lecturers and so on, for the purpose of utilizing and managing natural resources between the two institutions, and for developing the quality of human resources at these two institutions.
2. **Research and Community Service:** Both parties agreed to organize research and community service programs related to strengthening, implementing and developing science for the future of universities, national and religious communities.
3. **Publication:** both parties agree to carry out the exchange of publication personnel who have quality educational and scientific qualifications and are in accordance with publication quality standards; and publish the results of research/research

and service through jointly published books, or in the form of research results in the form of journal articles, or other forms of publication with the terms and conditions set by each of these institutions.

Section 2

ADMINISTRATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF ACTIVITIES

1. Each institution will propose techniques for managing and funding each proposed collaborative activity which is submitted in detail in the activity proposal.
2. The implementation of activities is technically regulated by the Institutions and Institutions or Institutional Units involved in this collective agreement, both within the IAI Al-Qodiri Jember environment and within the Pirens Institute of Business Management and Administration, India
3. Each funding proposal submitted is based on the provisions of financial system legislation, applicable policies and procedures, and can be changed by each relevant policy/provision holder.
4. For each proposed activity, the two institutions will jointly determine specific requirements and information, for example regarding the activity reporting system, place to stay, amount of honorarium, transportation, implementation time, working hours/lecture hours, and other specific matters for ensure both parties have a thorough understanding of the proposed costs and the adequacy and availability of funds for the activity.
5. Each institution will control funds at the activity implementation level, be fully responsible for the smooth running of the activity, and be obliged to provide reports to the leadership of each institution.
6. Both institutions will appoint *contact person* who functions as a facilitator and activity coordinator and manages all activity points in detail, including compiling/receiving/ sending activity proposals.

Article 3

VALIDITY PERIOD

This cooperation agreement is valid for a period of 5 (five) years from the signing of this agreement by THE PARTIES, and can be extended, changed or canceled with written agreement from THE PARTIES.

Article 4

PROBLEM SOLVING

If there are differences or misunderstandings between the PARTIES, then It was agreed to resolve it through deliberation as best as possible to reach consensus.

Article 5

ETC

1. The engagement of the PARTIES in this cooperation agreement is adjusted to the abilities of the PARTIES and continues to maintain and refer to the applicable rules and regulations.
2. Matters that have not been regulated in this cooperation agreement will be regulated later with the approval of the PARTIES in an Addendum.

Article 6 CLOSING

This cooperation agreement is made in 2 (two) copies. Each one reads the same on stamped paper and has the same legal force after being signed and stamped by the PARTIES.
